

Parramatta Campus Child Minding Service Terms

- Linx Institute Child Minding Service is not a regulated setting. Therefore it is not a childcare centre and children cannot be left in the child minding service whilst parents are not on premises. If parents wish to leave the premises, your children will need to be taken out of the Child Minding Service and taken with you.
- Linx Institute Child Minding Service is only for students studying with Linx Institute. Students can use the child minding service whilst they are in class only.
- Bookings are essential and can be made by phoning 1300 659 772 or in person at the Linx Institute national support office reception (located in Parramatta) the week prior. Permanent bookings are not available.
- Parents must accommodate for their child's day by bringing in their necessities. These include: nappies, bottles, milk, formula, dummies, wipes, food, fruit, etc.
- No meals containing traces of nuts or eggs are permitted.
- Children who are unwell or have a temperature higher than 38 degrees will not be able to attend the service.
- If the child minding facility is being used, the timetable for classes must be followed and all students should be attending on time and dropping children off before class starts.
